- Colour:** Medium straw with vibrant green hues.
Nose: Intense citrus blossom and green apple.
Palate: Concentrated lemon and lime flavours, lemon pith, with hint of lanolin. Will develop honey and toast characters with age.

WINEMAKERS COMMENTS

- Source:** Marrowbone Road Pokolbin.
Vinification: Hand harvested, crushed but not destemmed allowing free draining juice. Cold settled, fermented over three weeks, followed by three months on lees building palate weight.
