With the recent appointment of new General Manager, Belinda Stapleton, Bimbadgen is enjoying a revitalization, investing \$1 million into renovating its tourism offering and relaunching a fresh and vibrant Cellar Door and award-winning restaurant Esca.

Esca Bimbadgen has a long reputation for award winning regional cuisine, winning the NSW and National best ‘Restaurant in a Winery’ in 2019 and best ‘National Tourism Restaurant’ in 2018 and is now recognised in the Savour Australian Hall of Fame. As a pioneer of fine dining in the Hunter Valley, Esca is dedicated to showcasing Bimbadgen’s wine, meticulously paired with prestigious local produce by the team.

After undergoing an extensive renovation, Esca will re-open late September 2020. The new look is designed to showcase the spectacular views from the dining room and balcony, with elegant soft interiors complimenting its natural wine country location. French green wood wash is complimented by Tasmanian Oak furniture and natural stone creating a serene atmosphere for a long winery lunch or dinner overlooking the spectacular vineyards.

In the Cellar Door, the refreshed Bimbadgen experience continues to delight. From the moment you walk through the main entry, you are taken into the heart of the winery operations, with stainless steel vats prominently on display as you follow the stairs down into the bright and airy cellar door.

General Manager, Belinda said “Bimbadgen Cellar Door is one of the Hunter’s most visited cellar doors and we want to provide our guests with the ultimate wine country experience. Our new cellar door is designed to provide the perfect backdrop for viewing the intricate colours of our wines and reminding our visitors why visiting the country is so refreshing.” This is reflected in the new design through contemporary Caesarstone benches, wine barrel adorned walls and suspended greenery, bringing the outside in.

The refurbishment has also seen the launch of a striking in new Members Lounge, taking pride of place at one end of the cellar door with stunning views across the Barrington ranges. Painted in moody black and fitted with tasting tables and lounges, the space is sure to convert our visitors to Bimbadgen members in no time!
