Bimbadgen Ridge 2021 Chardonnay

Bimbadgen's striking bell tower is positioned on a ridge overlooking Australia's oldest wine region – The Hunter Valley. This has been the inspiration for Bimbadgen's Ridge range, a fruit driven, easy-drinking blend of varieties made to enjoy now.
